Whereas John Agnew of Washington County was at a County Court of the said County held at Elizabeth town on the first Monday of December last indicted and found guilty of Feloniously Stealing and Carrying away, on the tenth day of November seventeen hundred and ninety one, one pair of Leather Breeches of the value of twenty Shillings current Money of the goods and Chattles of John Ryan whereupon it was considered and adjudged by the said Court that the Sheriff of Washington County aforesaid, take the aforesaid John Agnew to Baltimore town to work and labour on the roads in Baltimore County for the term Six Months. And that the Sheriff aforesaid deliver him to the Overseer of the said roads for that purpose. And whereas it is represented by the Chief Justice of the said Court that the said
