

that he run away from the Turnpike Road of the said County for the space of Eighteen Days. it was therefore adjudged by the said Court that the said Peter Murphy's term of Labouring on the public roads in the County aforesaid should be extended six Months from the Expiration of the term of his conviction first Sentence. And it appearing by the petition of the said Peter Murphy which is corroborated by the Supervisor, Commissioners and Commanding Overseer of the Turnpike Roads, that he has faithfully served the term for which he was first adjudged and they also recommending him to the Clemency of Government I have thought it proper to pardon the said Peter Murphy and do hereby Order and direct that he be forthwith discharged from the service aforesaid Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty eighth Day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety two

Whereas Joseph Hall late of Baltimore County Yeoman was presented by the Jurors for the body of Baltimore County aforesaid for that he on the tenth Day of July last at the County aforesaid with force and Arms one Chaise of the value of six pence Current Money of Maryland of the goods and Chattels of George Hunter then there found, then and there feloniously did steal take and carry away against the Peace Government and Dignity of the State of Maryland. And that on the twenty second day of August instant on a trial of the facts contained in the above recited Indictment the above named Joseph Hall was found guilty
