 John Moale the said Suce at the time of her so attempting to
 poison on the said John Moale being a Slave to wit at the County
 aforesaid Contrary to the Act of a in such Case Made and
 Provided and against the Peace Government and Dignity of
 the State of Maryland of which Offence she the said Suce hath
 been Convict before Samuel Chase Esquire Chief Justice and
 George Salmon Esquire Associate Justice of a Court of Oyer and
 Terminer and Goal Delivery held for Baltimore County at the
 Court House in the same County the second Tuesday in August
 in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
 Ninety two Never the less we grant unto her the said Suce
 our firm Peace and will not that she suffer any Corporal or
 other punishment therefore but that she shall stand and be in
 the same plight and Condition to all Intents and purposes
 whatsoever as if the Crime whereof she the said Suce hath been
 Convict had never been done or committed. Provided the
 Sheriff of Baltimore County shall, and he is hereby required
 and Commanded within sixty days from the date hereof to sell
 and dispose of the said negro Suce for the benefit of the State
 to some person or persons who shall engage to transport or cause
 her to be transported to someone of the west India Islands or otherwise
 beyond the seas, from whence she is never to return into this or either
 of the United States Given under the seal of the State of Maryland
 this eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred and Ninety two
