To all our Bailiffs and good people to whom these presents shall come Greeting

Whereas George Brown late of Prince Georges County, was at a General Court for the western Shore of the State of Maryland begun and held at the City of Annapolis on the second Tuesday and ninth day of October instant indicted tried and found guilty of Stealing one Bay gelding of the value of Thirty Pounds Current Money of Maryland of the goods and Chattels of a certain Edward Nichols. Whereupon it was considered by the Judges of the General Court aforesaid that the said George Brown do serve and labour for one Year and three Months on the public Roads of Baltimore County or in making or repairing or cleaning the Streets or Bason of Baltimore Town And whereas several respectable Characters have earnestly solicited the interposition of Government in his favour and recommended him as a fit object of Mercy I have thought it proper to pardon the said George Brown for the offence aforesaid and do therefore hereby Order and direct that he be forthwith discharged from the sentence aforesaid Given under the seal of the State of Maryland this seventh day of October in the year
