Whereas a certain John Montgomery the younger
Esquire Attorney at Law late of the County
of Mifflin in the State of Pennsylvania
stands charged with an assault and battery
committed on Thomas Smith Esquire President
of the Court of Common Pleas of the fourth Circuit in the said
State in consequence of the conduct of the said Thomas Smith
in the execution of his Office aforesaid as appears by an
Official Copy of the Record of a presentment of the Grand
Jury at a Court of general Quarter Sessions of the Peace
held for the County of Mifflin in the said State which
Copy hath been transmitted to me under the Seal of the
Clerk of the said Court. And Whereas it is represented
to me by his Excellency Thomas Mifflin Esquire Governor
of the said State of Pennsylvania that the said John Mont-
gomery having fled from the Justice of Pennsylvania
is now resident of Harford County of this State And
Whereas his Excellency the said Thomas Mifflin Governor
of the said State of Pennsylvania hath demanded of me
that the said John Montgomery be delivered up to be removed
to the said State having Jurisdiction of the Crime where
with he stands charged. You are therefore hereby
Commanded to take into your Custody the Body of the
said John Montgomery if he shall be found in your
County and him safe keep, so that you have him before
me at the City of Annapolis with all convenient
dispatch, to the end that he be put to answer the charge
Exhibited against him as aforesaid. Given under my
