

convicted in Baltimore County Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal delivery August term last of an Attempt to poison the aforesaid John Moale on condition that the Sheriff of Baltimore County aforesaid should within sixty Days from the said eighteenth Day of September sell and dispose of her for the benefit of the State to some person or persons who should engage to transport or cause to be transported to some one of the West Indies Islands or otherwise beyond the Seas the said Suce never to return back into this or either of the United States And Whereas it is represented by the said Sheriff that the time limited in the condition of the said pardon will expire before he can have an Opportunity of complying therewith and requesting that the same may be extended I have therefore thought proper to extend the time for carrying the condition of the said pardon into execution to the tenth day of December next

Whereas by the Petition of Jesse Walker of Baltimore County it is represented that he was lately employed as a Millwright by a certain Andrew Wallace who for the services of the said Walker give him an Order on John Roberts for the sum of twelve Dollars dated the thirtieth Day of October last on which Order (by some Mistake) twenty Dollars were received for which he was Charged before Samuel Chase Esq. with forgery and by him Recognized to appear at the Next Criminal Court to answer for the said Offence it is also represented that he has from his infancy supported the Character of a sober Honest inoffensive Citizen that he is married and
