Whereas it is represented that at the last Court held for Frederick County the grand Jury of the said County found a Presentment against Mary Suckett wife of Capt<sup>m</sup> John Suckett of said County for feloniously Stealing a piece of Callico. And Whereas by the Depositions of several persons inhabitants of the County aforesaid relative to the said charge It appears that the interposition of Government might be properly exercised in her case

I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all Proceedings at Law for the said offence do cease and determine and no further Prosecution be had or carried on against her the said Mary Suckett for or concerning the same
