Whereas by the Petition of Mary Curry
of Baltimore County it is represented that at January term
last in the Criminal Court of the said County of Baltimore
she was convicted of Stealing four Yards of Linnen the
property of Joseph Slater that her Husband is now at
the point of Death and then four small Children without
protection or property to support them and must if the
punishment adjudged by the Court is inflicted become a
burthen to the County that she is considerably advanced in
Years and unable to compensate by her labour the injury
she has done to Society, And Whereas three of the Justices
of the said Court together with several respectable Inhabi-
tants of Baltimore town have recommended her to the Cle-
mency of Government I have thought it proper to pardon
the said Mary Curry for the offence aforesaid and do therefore
herby Order and direct that she be forthwith discharged
from the sentence adjudged by the said Court
Given under the Seal of the State of Maryland this fourth
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and Ninety three
