Whereas Margaret Bandle of Baltimore County Spinster stands presented by the Grand Jury of the said County for that she on the eighteenth Day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety two at the County of Baltimore with force and Arms, One Yard and a half of Ballis of the value of four Shillings Current Money of Maryland of the goods and Chattels of Maddox Andrew then there found then and there feloniously did steal take and carry away against the Peace Government and Dignity of the State of Maryland. And Whereas it is represented by the said Maddox Andrew and several others, respectable Inhabitants of Baltimore town that she is a hard working woman with seven small Children and has supported a good Character and they earnestly solicit the interposition of Government in her favor I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at Law for the said offence do cease and determine and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against her for or concerning the same
