Whereas Robert Dunsmore of Baltimore County stands presented by the Grand Jury of the said County, for that he on the tenth Day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety three with force and arms, three silver table spoons of the Value of ten shillings current Money of Maryland and of the Goods and Chattles of John Stricker and one silver can of the value of Three pounds current Money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattles of John Merryman, did steal take and carry away against the peace Government & dignity of the State of Maryland. and the said Robert Dunsmore entered into a recognizance to appear before the Court of Oyer and terminer for the County aforesaid at this present November term for a trial of the facts above charged. and Whereas it is prayed by the
