by three of the Justices of the said Court together
with several respectable inhabitants
of Baltimore town and also by the
persons from whom the goods were
stolen, as a proper object of public
clemency. I have thought proper to
order and direct that all proceedings
at law for the offences aforesaid
do cease and determine, and that
no further prosecution be had or
carried on against the said Robert
Dunsmore for or concerning the same
