of Frederick County, late the slaves of Haden
Edwards of Kentucky, and now the property
of Tho Holland Williams Esquire of Baltimore
and charged with having committed an
assault on the aforesaid Haden Edwards,
and Whereas Doctor Philip Thomas of
Frederick County has before Jacob Young
Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for
the said County, entered into a recognizance
under the penalty of forty pounds current
money, for the personal appearance of
the said Negroes Basil and Philip
before the Justices of Frederick County
Court, on the fourth Monday in March
next, to answer such matters and things
as shall then and there be objected
