A Pardon was issued by His Excellency
the Governor to Negro Bob the slave of
Daniel Bowley sentenced by the
Court of Oyer and Terminer for
Baltimore County to labour on the
Public Roads of Baltimore County
for the term of three years.

Bailliffs and good people
Tho: S. Lee to whom these presents shall
come greeting - Whereas
at a County Court began and held
at the Court House in and for the
County of Montgomery on the second
Tuesday of August in the year one
thousand seven hundred and eighty
nine Daniel Smith and Francis
Howard of the County aforesaid, Yeoman
were convicted of Burglary and Felony
and thereupon sentenced by the
Court aforesaid to serve and labour
