aforesaid for stealing and carrying away on  
the Eighteenth day of November in the year  
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred  
and Ninety four two Hats of the value of  
five shillings current Money of Maryland  
of the goods and Chattels of Hugh W. Furdy,  
and the said Joshua Anderson on trial  
by a Jury before the Justices of the Court  
of Oyer and Terminer &c for Baltimore  
County at a Court held in and for the  
said County on the third Tuesday in Novem-  
ber one thousand seven hundred and  
Ninety four for the trial of all Felonies  
&c in the said County committed, was  
found guilty thereof and was adjudged  
by the said Justices to work and labour  
for the space of three Months on the  
Public Roads of Baltimore County, or in  
making, repairing or cleaning the Streets  
or Bason of Baltimore Town; and  
whereas the said Joshua Anderson  
has been strongly recommended to me as
