

State aforesaid at a Court held for the Eastern
shore of the said State at Easton in the County
of Talbot aforesaid on the second Tuesday
of September in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and Ninety
four. Nevertheless we grant unto her
the said Leah our firm Peace, and will
not that she suffer any corporal or other
punishment therefor, but that she shall
stand and be in the same plight and
condition to all intents and purposes
whatsoever as if the crime aforesaid had
never been done or committed. Provided
that the Sheriff of Talbot County do before
the first day of April next sell and
dispose for the benefit of the State the
said Negro Leah to some person or persons
who shall engage by a legal obligation
to transport or cause to be transported
without delay the said Negro Leah to some
one of the British West India Islands
where she is to be sold as a slave, and from
whence she is never to return into this
