Whereas John Allen Thomas Esquire of Saint Mary's County attorney at Law was at March Term last in the County Court of the same County and by the Grand Jury for the Body thereof indicted for unlawfully extorsively and unjustly presuming to ask receive take and demand of and from a certain Joshua Thomas the sum of two hundred pounds of Tobacco at the rate of twelve shillings and six pence current Money per hundred as a fee for his appearance as attorney for the said Joshua Thomas the principal Debt and Damages or Balance of any Debt and Damages sued for and recovered against him the said Joshua Thomas not exceeding the sum of two thousand pounds of Tobacco or ten pounds sterling to the great Injury of the said Joshua Thomas. contrary to the form of the act of assembly in such case made
