ment and Dignity of the State. And whereas
the Associate Justices of the said County Court
have recommended the granting of a Noli
Prosequi on the said Indictment and
from the Circumstances disclosed to me it
appears that such an Interposition is
right and proper. I have determined
to order and direct that all Proceedings
at Law for or on Account of the said Charge
or Offence do cease and determine and
that no further prosecution be had or car-
ried on for or concerning the same. —
