State of Maryland: To Messrs
Jeremiah Yellott, Richard Gittings and
Thomas Coale of Baltimore Town. Whereas
by an act of Assembly made and passed
at November Session 1784. entitled "an
act for the sale of a Lot of Ground in
Baltimore Town, the Property of Thomas Walley."
It was provided and enacted, that if
it should appear, by a Valuation upon
oath, that the said Lot of Ground, would
without Improvements sell, when the
said Thomas Walley arrived at age for a
larger sum than the same sold for under
the said act. then upon Certificate thereof
from the Governor stating such Valuation
