nominate and appoint you and each
of you, to value the said Lot of Ground
being known and distinguished, on
the Plate of that Part of Baltimore Town
called Fells Point, by the Number seven
one, without having any regard to the
Improvements erected thereon, which
said Valuation you are to make upon
oath, - and when such Valuation shall
be so made, by you - you are to return
