and one other note of the value of eighteen pounds fifteen  
shillings which said notes were of the goods and Chattels of  
Marcus McCausland, and the said James Kelner on trial by  
a Jury before the Justices of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and  
goal Delivery for Baltimore County at a Court held in and  
for the said County on the second Tuesday in January last for  
the trial of all felonies and other crimes offences and misde-  
meanors in the said County committed, was found guilty thereof,  
and was adjudged by the said Court to serve and labour on the  
Public Roads of Baltimore County &c. for the term of three  
years; and Whereas the said James Kelner has been recommen-  
ded to me by a number of respectable Citizens of Baltimore Town  
as an object deserving the interposition of Government;  
I have therefore thought proper to pardon the said James  
Kelner for the offence aforesaid and do hereby order and  
direct that he be forthwith discharged from the service to  
which he hath been adjudged. Given under my hand,  
and the Seal of the State of Maryland, this Twenty ninth  
day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
hundred and ninety seven.
