Greeting; Whereas Negro Phill late the slave
of Harry Dorsy Gaugh of Baltimore County was presented by
the Jurors for the Body of Baltimore County aforesaid for
stealing and carrying away on the twelfth day of June in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
one vest pattern of the value of three shillings and nine
pence Current money, one piece of Nankeen of the value of
thirty seven shillings and six pence like money and one
piece of blue stuff of the value of fifteen shillings Current
Money of Maryland of the goods and Chattels of Jacob Tyson,
and the said Negro Phill on Trial by a Jury before the
Justices of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery
for Baltimore County at a Court held in and for the said
County on the second Tuesday in August in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six for the
trial of all felonies and other Crimes offences and Misde-
meanors in the said County committed, was found guilty
thereof and was adjudged the said said Court to serve and
labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County, or in mak-
ing repairing and cleaning the streets of Baltimore Town
for the Term of five years; and Whereas the said Negro Phill
has been recommended to me by a Number of respectable
Wise Citizens of Baltimore County as an object worthy
the interposition of Government, I have thought
