The State of Maryland to all our Bailiffs and good people
to whom these presents shall come greeting, Whereas it has
been represented to me, that a certain Conrad Guls was presented
and convicted at the present November session of Sidenick
County Court and that the Jury of the said Court has found
a verdict against him for Stealing a Bar of Iron the property
of James Marshall and John McMuney; and Whereas
the Court and Jury together with a ^{respectable} number of Citizens
of the said County have represented to me that the said
Conrad Guls had previous to the said offence supported a
good Character and prayed that a pardon might be
granted; I have in Consideration whereof thought
proper to pardon the said Conrad Guls for the offence
