County Greeting, Whereas Negro Rachel
was at a Court held for Kent County
at the Court House in the Town of Cheston
on the third Monday of March Seventeen hundred
and Ninety Eight, tried and convicted of House burning
and was sentenced to suffer Death for the said offence,
Now know ye that I have thought proper by and in
pursuance of the powers vested in me by Law to com-
mute and change the said sentence of Death against
the said Negro Rachel into banishment forever out of
the United States and to service until the end of the
year Eighteen hundred and six for the benefit of the
State of Maryland; the said Sheriff to take sufficient Bond
and security from the person to whom the said Negro
Rachel shall be delivered to comply fully with the aforesaid
conditions. Given under my hand and the seal of the

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Baltimore
County Greeting, Whereas Negro Lindy was
at a Court held for Baltimore County at the
Court House in the city of Baltimore on the
second Tuesday in January Seventeen hundred and
Ninety Eight, tried and convicted of House burning and was
sentenced to suffer death for the said offence, Now
