

know ye that I have thought proper by and in pursuance
of the powers vested in me by Law to commute and change
the said Sentence of Death against the said Negro Lindy
into banishment out of the United States and sale as a
Slave for life, and I do order and direct that the Sheriff
of Baltimore County shall within sixty days after the
date hereof cause the said Negro Lindy to be transported
out of the United States and sold as a Slave for life, for
the benefit of the State of Maryland, the said Sheriff to
take sufficient Bond and Security from the person to
whom the said Negro Lindy shall be delivered to comply
fully with the aforesaid Conditions, Given under my
hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this six-
teenth day of April Seventeen hundred and ninety eight
