City of Annapolis August 10th 1798

By His Excellency, John Henry Governor of
Maryland

A Proclamation

Whereas it has been represented to me that the Store house
of Robert McGill of Prince Georges County was on the
Seventeenth day of July consumed by fire and that on the
Twenty fourth day of the same month the Tobacco House
the property of Joseph Duwall was also consumed by fire
and that some malicious person or persons are supposed
to have wilfully set fire to the same; I have therefore thought
proper in pursuance of the powers vested in me by Law,
to issue this my Proclamation thereby offering full and
free pardon to any person being an accomplice in the
commission of the said Crime who shall discover the
perpetrators or perpetrators thereof, so that he she or they
or any of them be convicted thereof Given under my hand
and the seal of the State of Maryland this tenth day of
August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and ninety Eight

and found guilty of stealing a watch the property
of James Baxter and was by Baltimore city Court at August
Term seventeen hundred and ninety Eight, sentenced to serve
and labour on the Public Roads of Baltimore County
