The State of Maryland to all our Bailiffs and good people
Bon Ogle To whom these presents shall come greeting
Whereas Negro Jack of Montgomery County was arraigned and found guilty of breaking and entering the dwelling house of Thomas Davis, and was by the Court of the said County at March Term last sentenced to be hanged, Now know ye that I have thought proper by and in pursuance of the powers vested in me by Law, to pardon the said Negro Jack for the offence aforesaid, and do hereby order and direct, that said Negro Jack instead of suffering Death as aforesaid, stand and remain in the same plight and condition as if the said crime whereof he is convicted had never been committed, Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this second day of April Seventeen hundred and Ninety nine
