was by Baltimore County Court sentenced to serve
labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County for
and during the Term of seven years and Whereas
number of respectable persons have recommended the
said Adam Stone as an object worthy the interposition
of Government, I have therefore thought proper to
pardon the said Adam Stone for the offence aforesaid
and do hereby order, and direct that he be discharged
from the service to which he hath been adjudged.
