The State of Maryland To all our Bailiffs and good people
To whom these presents shall come greeting;

Know all men That whereas William Delasere has been convicted in
Baltimore County Criminal Court of forging the
name of Mrs. Bulony and was by the said Court sentenced to one
year imprisonment, and whereas the said William Delasere
has been recommended to me as an object worthy the inter-
position of Government, I have therefore thought proper
to pardon the said William Delasere for the offence aforesaid
on condition of his leaving the United States and
not returning therein again. Given under my hand and
the seal of the State of Maryland this Twenty
second day of April Seventeen hundred and ninety
