for secreting a Negro man the property of John Pollitt and  
Whereas a number of respectable persons have prayed that a  
Habeas Corpus may be granted, I have therefore thought proper  
to order and direct that all proceedings at Law for the said  
offence do cease and determine and that no further  
prosecution be had or carried on against the said Isaac  
M. Adams for or concerning the same, Given under my  
hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this Twenty  
ninth day of August Seventeen hundred and ninety nine  
attest Minian Pinkney Clk Ben Ayle

Whereas James Hunt stands charged with an attempt to  
commit a rape and was by Charles County Court at August  
Instant was adjudged to serve and labour on the public
