Whereas Henry Dickenson of Caroline County stands  
presented in two several presentments at the Court of  
the said County at October Term last for felony and  
Whereas a number of respectable persons have prayed  
that a Nolle prosequi might be granted, I have therefore  
thought proper to pardon the said Henry Dickenson,  
and do hereby order and direct that all proceedings  
at Law for the said offence do cease and determine  
and that no further prosecution be had or carried  
on against the said Henry Dickenson for or con-  
cerning the same— Given under my hand and the  
Seal of the State of Maryland this twelfth day of  
November Eighteen hundred

The Sentence of Death which passed by the  
Criminal Court of Baltimore County at a Special  
Court held on the first Tuesday in July last, and  
on which a Death warrant was issued by his  
Excellency the Governor for the Execution of Negro  
Simon the Slave of James Hedges of Baltimore County  
was commuted to transportation out of the United  
States and Sale for life as a slave and the  
Sheriff of Baltimore County was requested to take  
Bond with sufficient security from the Captain to  
comply with the said commutation, Given under my  
hand and <sup>the</sup> Seal of the State of Maryland this Twenty  
third day of November Eighteen hundred
