Whereas Francis Shadd of Cecil County was presented at Cecil County Court at August Term last for stealing two bushells of rye the property of John Simpkins Junr. and was by the said Court sentenced to serve and labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County for and during the term of one year, and Whereas the said Francis Shadd has been recommended to me as an object worthy the interposition of Government, I have therefore thought proper to order and direct, that he be discharged from the service to which he hath been adjudged, Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this Twenty Third day of November Eighteen hundred

Whereas it appears by the petition of Mary Freeman of Annapundel County that her slave Ismael was committed to the goal of the said County on the fiftenth day of September last as being accessory in stealing a Mare the property of Richard Darsey and praying that a Noli prosequi might be granted and Whereas the said Richard Darsey has stated to me that he does not believe that the said Negro Ismael is guilty of the said offence and has prayed that
