said Court sentenced to six months imprisonment and
standing in the pillory half an hour, and whereas it is
stated to me that the period for which the said Jacob Doyle
was sentenced to be confined is nearly expired, I have
thought proper to remit that part of the sentence which
respects his standing in the pillory - Given under my
