The State of Maryland To all our Bailiffs to whom these presents shall come Greeting, Whereas Esther Davis late of Baltimore County spinster, has been presented indicted arraigned and found guilty of murdering her infant Child on the tenth day of April last, and by the Justices of Baltimore Criminal Court Judicially sitting in the City of Baltimore in and for the County aforesaid, the second Monday in July last; sentenced to be hanged by the neck untill she be Dead; and Whereas the whole of the jury who tried the said Esther Davis, have stated that they found her guilty on presumptive Evidence merely, and that it appeared in Evidence on the trial that she had always supported a good Character and was of good Temper and disposition, and have with several of the jury who were attending the said Court and other respectable Characters prayed that the said Sentence
