Whereas Greenbury Wilson of Baltimore County was presented at the Criminal Court of the said County at July Term last for stealing four Dollars the property of a certain Caleb Hutton, and whereas it appears from the Petition of the said Greenbury Wilson that he in Company with a certain Thomas Greaves met with a certain Caleb Hutton who proposed to play with them at prick the loop, that they did play and won from the said Hutton which he willingly paid them, but observed at the same time that he knew not what excuse he should make to his Father as the money he had lost was the money he received at market, that the said Hutton to avoid the displeasure of his Father swore that the said Greaves and the Petitioner had robbed him of four Dollars, and whereas a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the said County have Certified their belief of the facts stated in the said Petition and have prayed that a *reli prosequi* might be granted, I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at Law against the said Greenbury Wilson do cease and determine and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for or concerning the same, Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this fifth day of October Eighteen hundred and Two
