Smith Greeting, The General Assembly of Maryland
reposing special confidence in your integrity and
abilities have appointed you Senator to represent this
State in the Senate of the United States from the third
day of March next until the fourth day of March
Eighteen Hundred and nine Given under my hand
and the Seal of this State this Twenty second day of
November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight
hundred and two and in the Twenty seventh year
of the Independence of the United States of America

The State of Maryland Do wit Whereas David Mox stands
presented by the Grand jury of Baltimore Court at November
Term Instant for instigating a certain John Moller to steal a
horse and afterwards receiving said horse knowing him to
be stolen on the Evidence of said Moller, and Whereas it appears
further that the said Moller was presented for stealing the same
and that the day previous to his Trial he made above accusation
it appearing to me by the representation of a number of respectable
persons that the said Mox always had an unimpeached Character
prior to this accusation and it also being proved by the Evidence
