Whereas Barton Brashears alias Thomas Darnall late of
Baltimore County Yeoman, was presented at Baltimore
County Criminal Court at November Term last for feloniously
and fraudulently forging and counterfeiting on the tenth day
of August last, sundry Tobacco Notes of Queen Anns Warehouse
Wells and Syles being Inspectors; for four hogheads of Tobacco
and whereas a Number of respectable persons acquainted with
the said Brashears throughout his life have represented to me
that he hath heretofore supported a good Character and have
prayed the interposition of the executive authority in his
favor and in as much as the attempt of the said Brashears to
defraud was fortunately detected before any injury had
occurred or any loss actually sustained thereby, I have thought
proper to order and direct that all proceedings at Law against
the said Brashears for or on account of the said offences do
cease and determine, and that no further prosecution be had
or carried on against him for or concerning the same, on
condition that the said Brashears leave the State before the
first day of May next and never return thereto again during
his life; Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland
this Eighth day of December Eighteen hundred and Two.
