Whereas John Bablist Norris of Saint Marys County was presented at the Court of the said County at March Term last for feloniously taking and carrying away from the Store of George Hobb one and one half yards of white unbleached Cassimere; and Whereas it appears from a representation to me, that the said John Bablist Norris is innocent of the said charge and the Grand jury who found the presentment against him together with a number of respectable persons Inhabitants of the said County having prayed the granting of a Noli prosequi I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at Law against the said John Bablist Norris for or concerning the said offence do cease and determine, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for concerning the same given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this third day of February Eighteen hundred and three
