

fifteenth of December which said warrant was afterwards suspended by several respite dated December the fourth and by the last of which the execution of him the said William Chadwell was suspended and adjourned until the twenty first of January last before and at which time the sheriff of Montgomery County had resigned and no successor had qualified, and whereas the Chief Justice before whom the said Chadwell was tried hath represented unto me that the conviction was altogether on presumptive Testimony and hath recommended that a Commutation of the punishment of Death should be made on his behalf, and whereas sundry very respectable Characters who have been acquainted with the said Chadwell from his Infancy to this time have made favorable representations to me of the character of the said Chadwell until this accusation, and that as the proof of guilt was only presumptive they cannot believe him guilty of so atrocious an act so entirely contrary to the tenor of his former life and praying the interposition of the Executive in his favor I have therefore in consideration of the premises and in as much as from the various representations of the evidence made to me I am disposed to believe the guilt of the said Chadwell doubtful, I have therefore thought proper, and I do hereby Commit and Change the said sentence of Death against the said William Chadwell into labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County or in making or repairing the Streets or Basons of Baltimore Town and do hereby order and direct that instead of the said William Chadwell suffering Death as aforesaid that he shall labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County or in making or repairing the Streets or Bason of Baltimore Town for and during the Term of Three years, to be computed from the date of these presents Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland This fourth day of February Eighteen hundred and three
