City of Annapolis April 2^d 1803

The State of Maryland, To all our Bailiffs and good people
to whom these presents shall come greeting, Whereas
Matthew Walker late of Baltimore County was presented
at the Court of the said County for imprisoning and
retaining as slaves three Malays, and was by the said
Court at November Term last sentenced to eighteen months
imprisonment and fined one hundred Dollars and
Whereas it appears to me as well from Testimony which
has been adduced to me and which was not brought
forward at the Time of Trial, as from a review of what was
then exhibited, that the said Walker committed the aforesaid
offences ignorantly and under deception and with
no corrupt motives, and Whereas he has already
