The State of Maryland To the Sheriff of Kent County Greeting
Whereas George French of Kent County was at much Term
last at the Court of the said County found guilty of stealing
Sunday Bank notes, and was by the said Court sentenced
to serve and labour on the public Roads of Baltimore
County for the term of three years and Whereas repre-
sentation has been made unto me of divers Circumstances
in favor of the said George French, I have thought
proper to order and direct that the said sentence shall
be suspended, and do hereby suspend the same until
the first day of May next at which time you shall cause
the said sentence to be executed, unless otherwise com-
manded by Lawful authority; Given under my hand
and the seal of the State of Maryland this thirteenth
day of April Eighteen hundred and three
