The State of Maryland to all our Bailiffs and good people to whom these presents shall come greeting. Whereas Thomas Clarke of Baltimore County was presented by the Jurors for the body of Baltimore County for Manslaughter in killing a certain William Boyd, and the said T. Clarke on a trial by a Jury before the Justices of a Court of Oyer and Terminer and for the said County on the second Monday in July last for the trial of all Felonies and other Crimes, Offences or Misdemeanors in the said County committed, was found guilty thereof. And whereas the Jurors of the Petit Jury who tried the said Tho^s. Clarke have recommended him to me as a fit Object for the interposition of Government, I have therefore thought proper to pardon the said Tho^s. Clarke for the offence aforesaid.
