thought proper to pardon the said Peter
Slye for the offence aforesaid on this express
condition that the said Peter Slye do
within thirty days from this date depart
the State of Maryland, and do not at any
time thereafter return into any part
thereof, and if the said Peter Slye do
not fully and strictly comply with the
condition aforesaid. Then this Pardon
to be null and void so that no benefit
or advantage shall arise to the said
Peter Slye from the same or any part
thereof: Given under my hand and the
Seal of the State of Maryland the nine
teenth day of August in the Year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and
