The State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Calvert County greeting - Whereas Negro Frank slave of Basil Brooke of Calvert County was to have been executed on Friday the twenty ninth day of November in the year of our Lord the thousand eight hundred and six, which said execution was suspended by virtue of an Instrument of writing bearing date the twenty eighth Instant. Now know ye that in order to afford time for a more particular investigation into his case, I have thought proper to suspend the execution of the said Negro Frank to a more distant day and do therefore by these presents appoint Friday the twelfth day of January, eighteen hundred and six, for his execution at twelve of the Clock, on which day you are hereby required to take the said Negro Frank from
