Whereas Susanna Merryman of Saint Marys County was presented at Saint Marys County Court at August Term last, for taking into her possession, claiming, and making one Sow and four Shoats the property of Richard Badley - And whereas it appears from sundry depositions that have been forwarded to me that the said Sow and Shoats either belonged to the said Susanna Merryman or that she marked them believing them to be her property - And whereas the Grand Jury of the said County, have prayed that I would grant a Noli prosequi, I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at law against the said Susanna Merryman do cease and determine, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against the said Susanna Merryman for or concerning the same - Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty first day of March, in the Year eighteen hundred and six
