of Baltimore County has been charged with taking
Handkerchiefs of various colors from the store of Caleb
Meyman in the said County; and whereas the said Thomas
Lloyd has stated to me that he was intimidated at the time
of committing the said offence and has prayed the grant
of a Nolle prosequi; and whereas the said Caleb Meyman
together with several persons inhabitants of Baltimore
County, has recommended the said Thomas Lloyd as a
fit object for the interposition of government, I have thought
proper to order and direct, that all proceedings of law against
the said Thomas Lloyd do cease and determine, and that
no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for
or concerning the same given under the seal of the state of
Maryland, this Twenty first day of May, in the year of
our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred and six.
