Family which consists of a wife and four small Children  
whose support and maintenance entirely depend on his labour  
and whereas the said Beale Ismael together with several  
respectable persons Inhabitants of Baltimore County has  
recommended the said James Maydewill to the Clemency  
of Government I have thought proper to order and direct that  
the said James Maydewill be discharged from the confinement  
to which he hath been adjudged. Given under the Seal of

in the Year of our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred  
and six.
