Thomas Fenning of Baltimore County hath been indicted
and found guilty in the Court of Oyer and Terminer
and had delivery for the said County on the second
Monday in July in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and six for stealing one Dollar of the
Goods and chattels of Hugh Thompson and whereas
it has been represented to me that the said Fenning
hath a Family to support by his daily labour and the
said Hugh Thompson together with a number of respect-
able persons inhabitants of the City of Baltimore
having prayed the interposition of Government in
his favour I have therefore thought proper to per-
don the said Thomas Fenning for the offence aforesaid
and do hereby order and direct that he be released from
the service on the Roads to which he hath been adjudged
by the said Court of said County, Given under my
hand and the seal of the State of Maryland the
Eighteenth Day of September in the year of our
Lord Eighteen Hundred and six
