The State of Maryland to all our Bailiffs and good
People to whom these Presents shall come greeting. Where
Francis Barclay late of Baltimore County has been
heretofore indicted at the Criminal Court of Baltimore
County at July Term last for receiving stolen goods knowing
them to be stolen - And whereas it has been represented
to me that the Father of the said Barclay fell in
the War of the Revolution - that the person charged
has been regularly bred to Merchandise - and has
conducted himself honestly up to the present charge
and that the only witness on whose testimony he was
convicted is one of a Gang of Robbers, and whereas a
number of respectable persons have united in petition-
ing for his pardon, I have therefore thought proper
to pardon the said Barclay for the offence afore-
said and do hereby order and direct that he be released
from the service to which he hath been adjudged by
