

The State of Maryland to wit whereas a certain George Logue late of Baltimore County has been presented and found guilty at Baltimore County Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery at March Term last of Stealing one Bay Gelding the property of George Bartol and stands presented in the said Court in another case for stealing sundry articles the property William Vanwick and John Dorsey - and whereas the Honourable John Scott chief Justice and George Goldsmith Presbury and Job Smith associate Justices of the said Court have stated to me that the said George Logue in consequence of an intimation of the part of the said Court that they would intercede with the Government in his behalf testified against the prisoners who some time since broke jail and killed George Working - and whereas the said John Scott George G Presbury and Job Smith Esquires have prayed that I would pardon the said George Logue for the offences I have thought proper to pardon him for the said offences and do hereby order and direct that for the said last offence all proceedings at law against the said George Logue do cease and determine, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for or on account of the same - Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Maryland this sixteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred and eight
