The State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Worcester County Greeting. Whereas Stephen Horsey late of Worcester County yeoman hath been indicted arraigned and found guilty of murder and by the Justices of a special Court Judicially sitting at the town of Snow Hill in and for the said County on Tuesday the sixth day of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred and ten was sentenced to be hanged by the neck until he be dead - These are therefore to will and require, as also to charge and command you, that on or before twelve of the clock on Friday the thirteenth day of July in the year eight hundred and ten, you take the said Stephen Horsey from your Prison, and him safely convey to the Gallows in the County aforesaid, the common place of execution of Malefactors, and there the said Stephen Horsey hang by the neck on the said Gallows until he be dead, for all which this shall be your sufficient power and authority.
